

# MAJOR REORGANIZATION OF NAOTC

## PUBLICATIONS

Up to this point, Ed Gardner had been doing the publication at home and at a price very much under commercial prices. However, due to ill health, Ed Gardner was forced to resign that summer and the new board of directors, elected at the North Haven convention decided to separate the current news and want adds into a possibly monthly The First Edition under Co-editors Dan Cupper and Carl Loucks with Jeff Asay assuming the editorship of The Timetable Collector which would be issued quarterly. The present numbering system of The Timetable Collector started with Quarterly Issue No. 1 dated Nov. 15, 1977.
