Thirty-five members attended the convention. Twenty two were from the local area, 7 others from the west and 6 from other areas of the country. The New England area was chosen to be the site of the 1972 convention. Memorial to Bill Wagner of Richmond, IN who died on Nov. 4, 1971 (Wagner Award in his memory.)
